Miscellaneous Opportunities to Help:

Check in children: Check in families at computer from 10:10 a.m. to 10:40 a.m. in Narthex Sunday mornings

Nursery and Toddler Laundry: Launder the crib sheets and blankets at your home weekly. (detergent supplied)

Substitute Teacher: Fill in when Caravan Leaders are unavailable. Curriculum and supplies are provided.

Office Assistant: Assist in church office with light office duties for the Children's Ministries.

Children's Ministries Communication: Assist with phone calls, emails, and mailings from home or church office

Children's Ministry Hospitality Team: We need people on Sunday mornings to perform the following:

a. Escort new families from the Narthex to Faith Hall

b. Serve as a hostess in either Faith Hall or the Narthex and answer questions regarding our Children's Program

c. New Families Welcome Table: Manage and take registration information for new families.

Coffee Break for Parents: Adults are needed to help serve coffee to parents of children who are hospitalized at Palm Beach Children's Hospital as part of our monthly mission project. (Third Thursday of the month)
